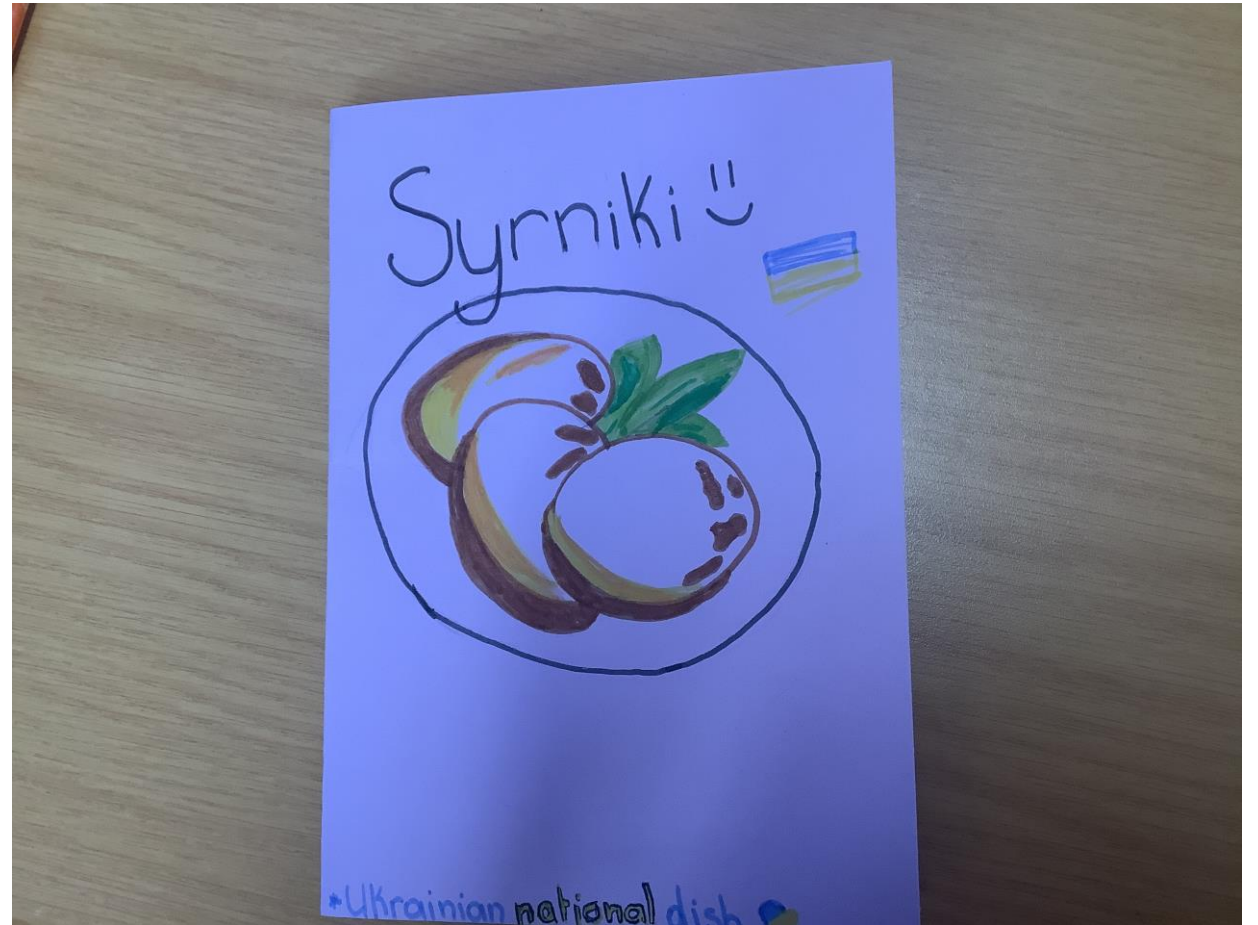


With our Ukrainian Visitors we wanted to:

Considerations:

- Access: Think about how to remove barriers to participation, such as language
- Translate information regarding events, use translators during event
- Safety and wellbeing. Consider how to provide a safe, friendly environment
- Support where possible, provide signposting in native language
- Create participatory spaces, empower people to work things out for themselves e.g. theatre example
